A completed Gina Estrada Sullivan Scholarship Application must accompany essay.

Reference letters confirming community involvement and/or academic leadership is suggested.

Rules of Eligibility:

Must be a current high school senior attending Estrella Foothill High School. Must receive written recommendation from school guidance counselor/teacher verifying student is college or trade school bound.
